

# BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

## RESIDENTIAL DUMPSTERS

VEHICLES OR TRUCKS THAT SERVE AS A WASTE DISPOSAL OPTION AND MOBILE STORAGE CONTAINER UNITS (PODS)

## SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A completed permit application stating the following:
  - dates for dumpster
  - size & type of dumpster
- 2. A plat of survey indicating location of dumpster

NOTE:

If the use of a dumpster is needed <u>as part of a permitted job</u> for a re-roof, demolition, or construction, a separate dumpster permit is not required but the general guidelines below must be followed.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Dumpsters and mobile storage containers must be stored on private property.
- Dumpsters and mobile storage containers may be permitted in the front yard for 30 days. Mobile storage containers must be on paved or gravel surface. An extension of 30 days must be approved by the Board of Trustees.
- Dumpsters stored on the side or rear yard may be permitted for 60 days. An extension of the 60 day period must be approved by the Board of Trustees.
- Mobile storage containers are allowed on the side or rear yard but not longer than 30 days.

NOTE:

Dumpsters are permitted in the street <u>only</u> as a <u>last resort and with</u> <u>strict conditions</u>. Applicants must demonstrate that alternative private property locations are not feasible. If permission is granted to store a unit on the street, it shall only be allowed for 14 days and must adhere to reflective barricade and traffic cone restrictions.
